TYPES OF SOCIAL DISORGANISATION

Individual Disorganisation

- When the patterns and roles of individual members are confused, it is called Individual Disorganisation
- For example: Delinquents, criminals, drug addicts, Alcoholic

Family Disorganisation

- Family Disorganisation includes any weakness, maladjustment or dissolution of the ties binding the members of the group together.
- For Example: Family tension, desertion or divorce

TYPES OF SOCIAL DISORGANISATION

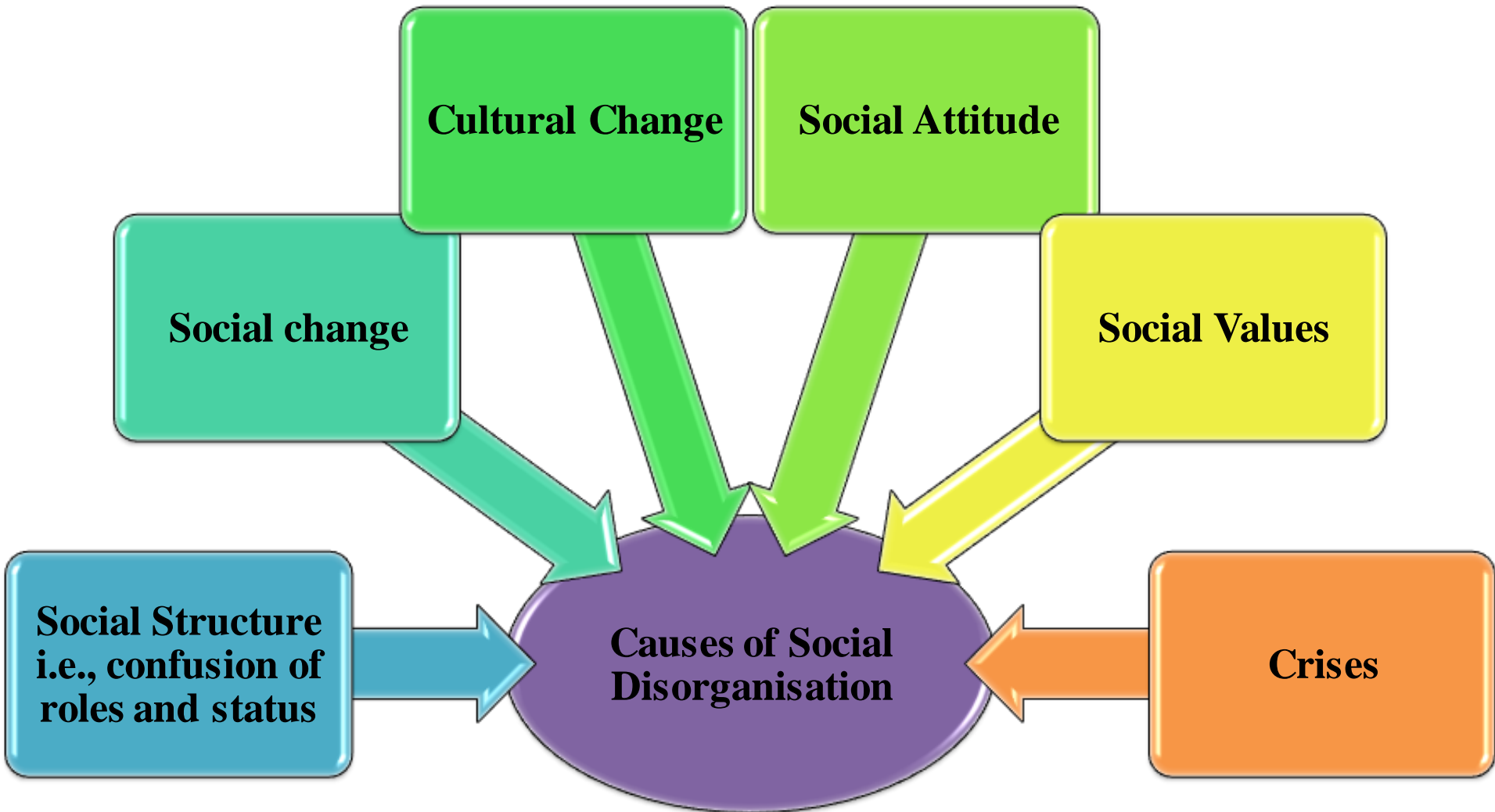
Community or National Disorganisation

- Partial or complete breakdown of the groups, institutions and association can be term as community disorganisation
- For example: rural community disorganisation, political corruption, migration, unemployment,

International Disorganisation

- When mutual understanding and relationship among the nations breakdown, it is International Disorganisation
- For example: revolutions, war
