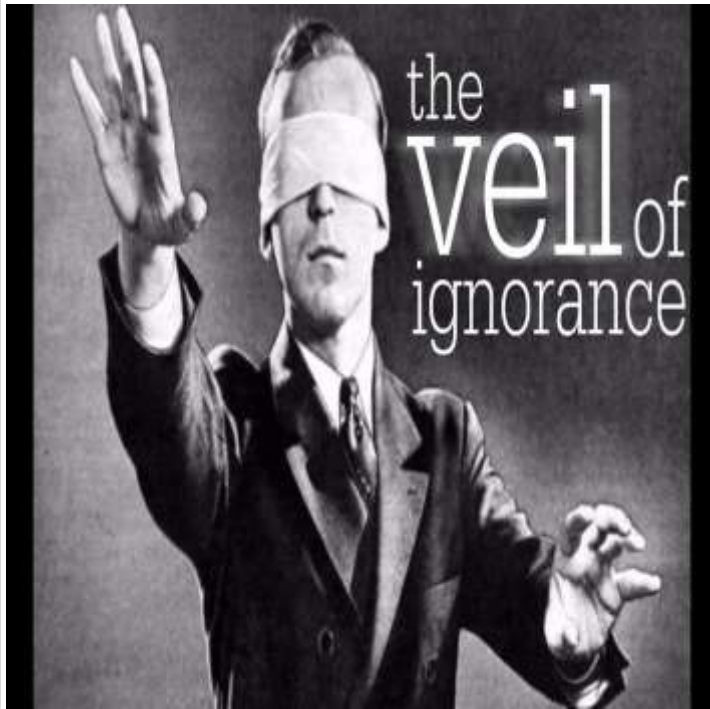

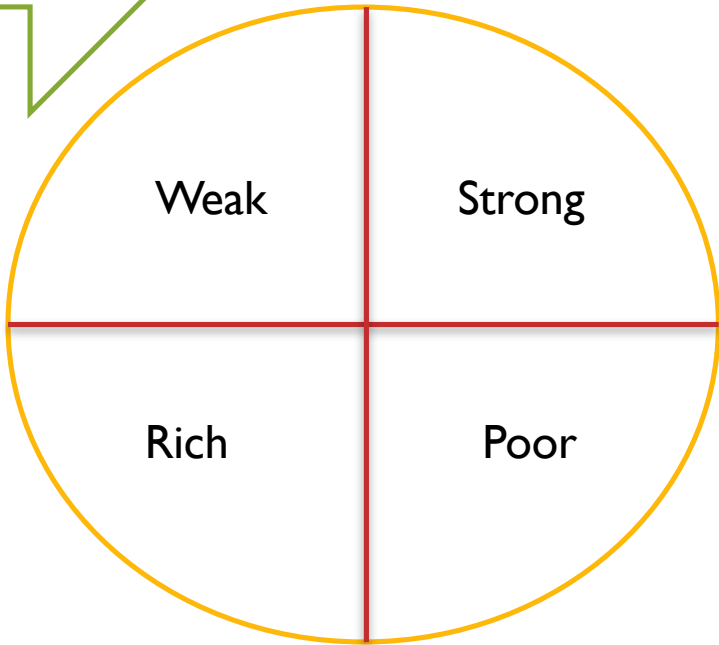
# Rawlsian conception of Social Justice

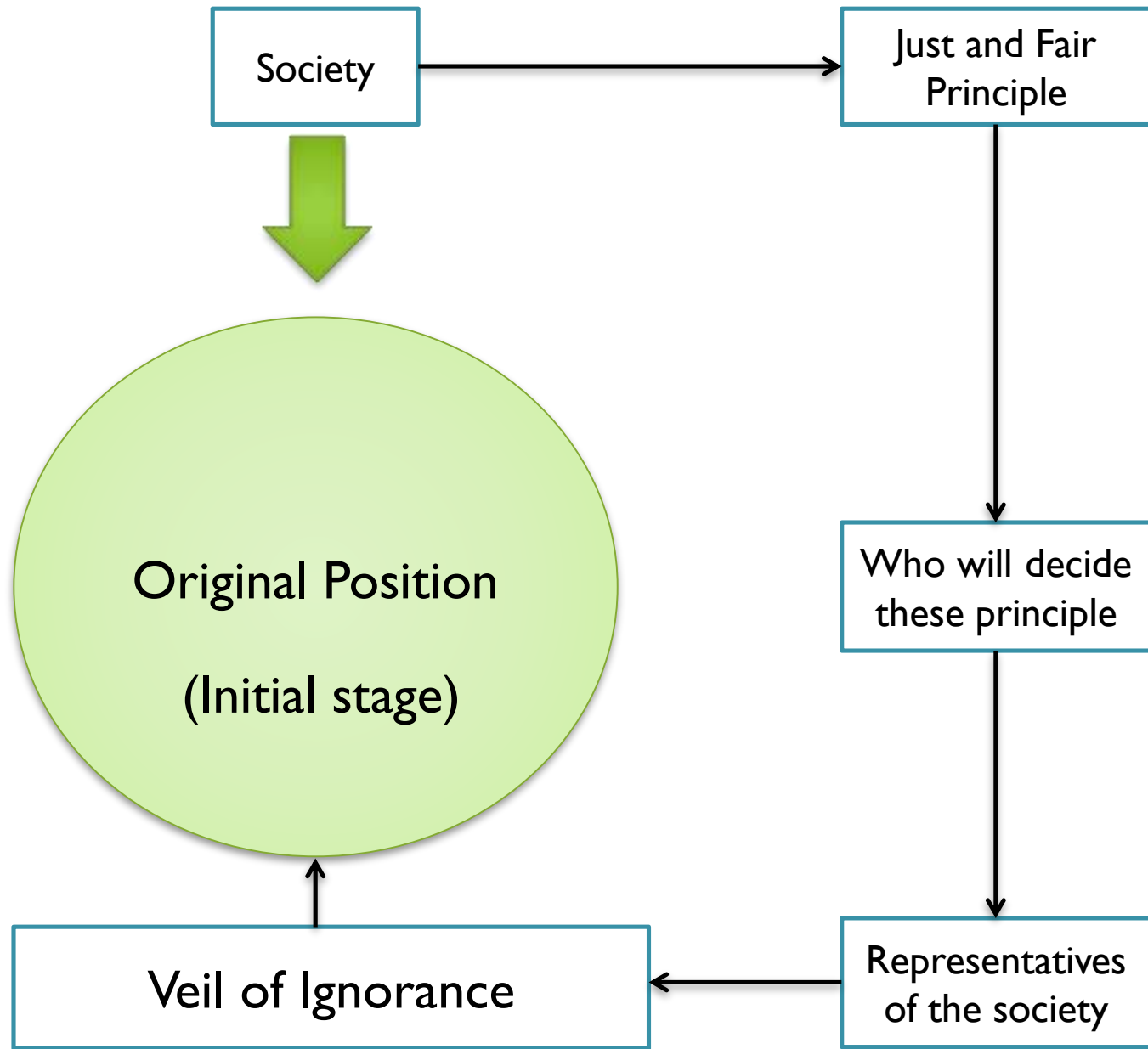

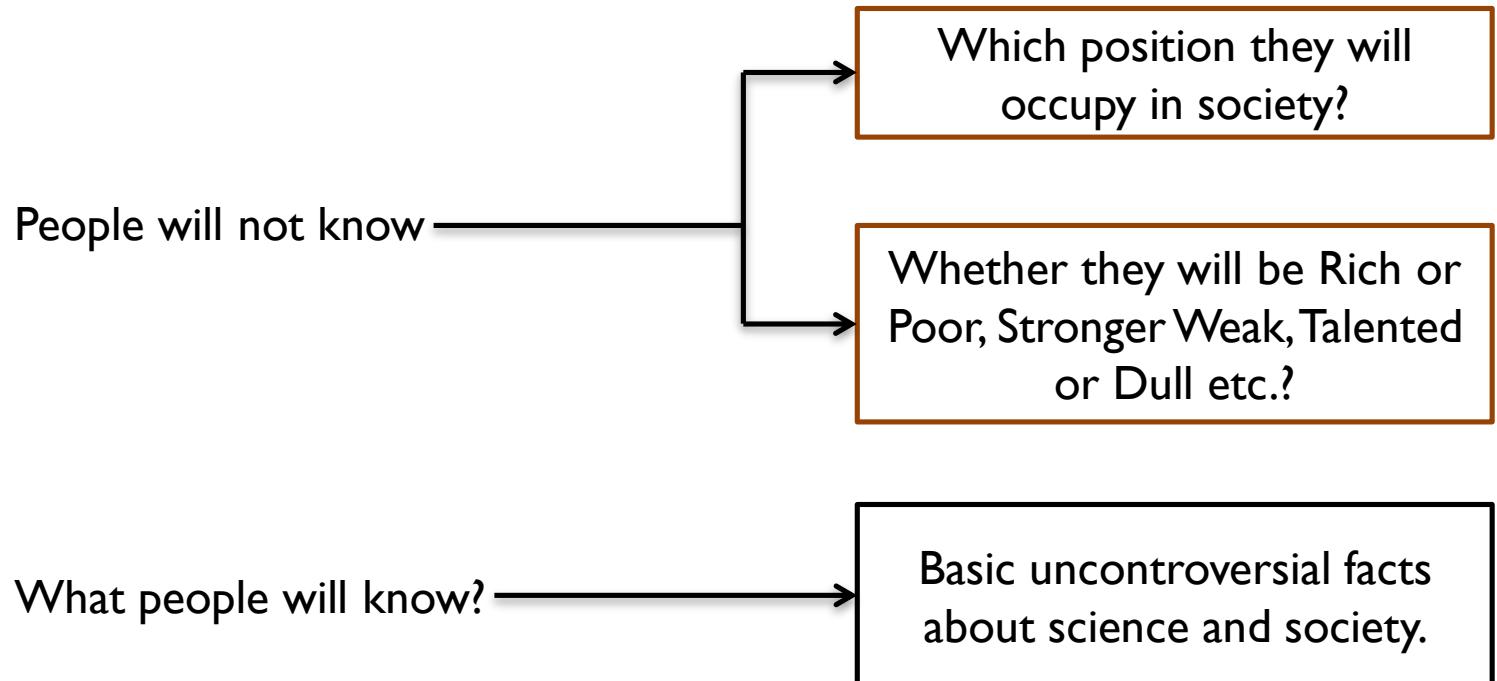


# What is Original Position?

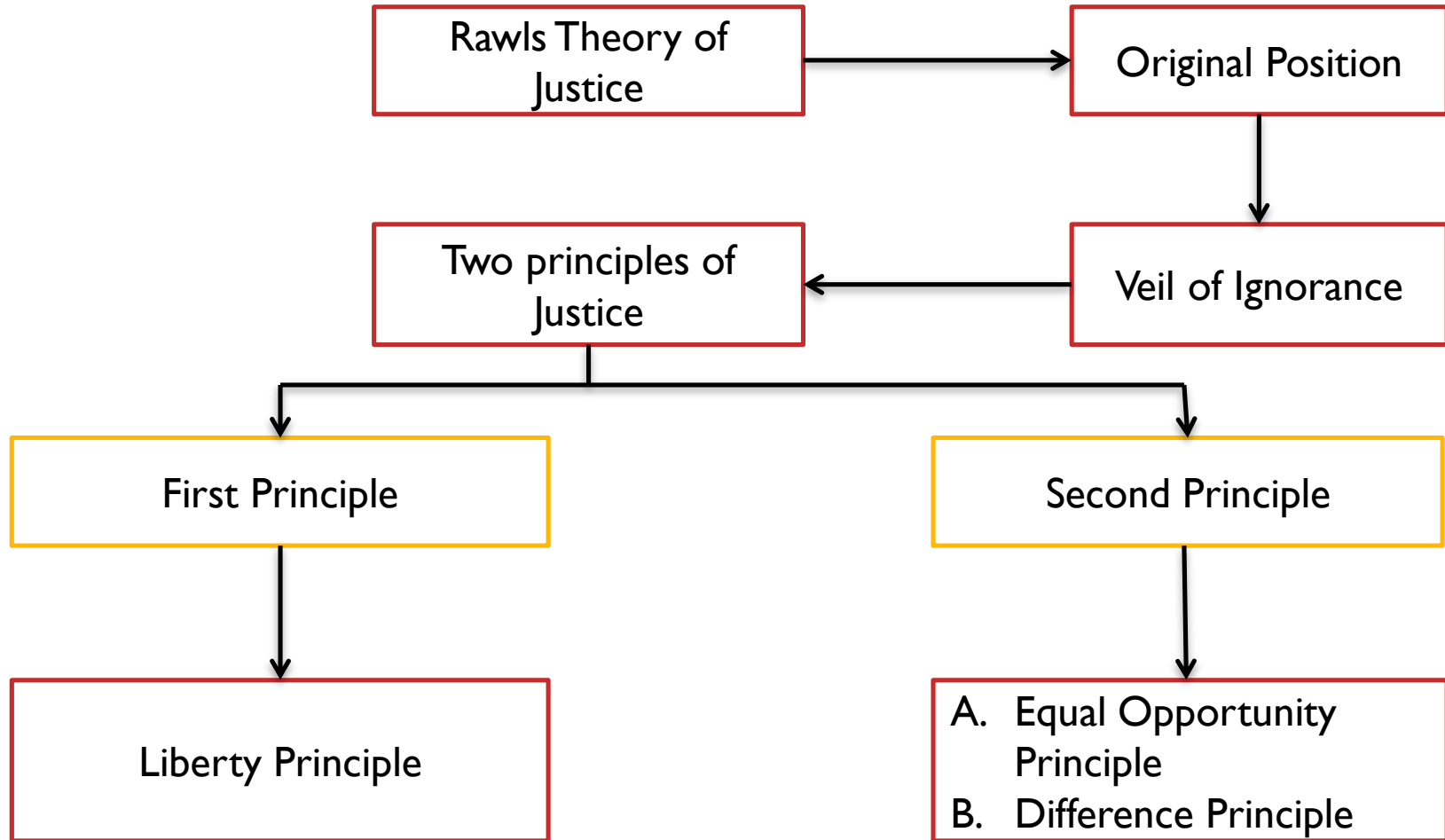
- ❑ A hypothetical situation prior to the starting of society.
