MEANING OF TEACHING

- ▣ Teaching is to impart knowledge, develop understanding and skills.
- ▣ In narrow sense it is associated with 3Rs'- reading, writing and arithmetic
- ▣ However in wider sense, it implies-7Rs'- reading, writing, arithmetic, rights responsibilities, relationships and recreation.

MEANING OF TEACHING(Contd..)

- ▣ Teaching is a relationship which is established among three focal points in education-the teacher, the students and the subject matter.
- ▣ It is a very complex art of guiding students through a variety of selected experiences towards the attainment of appropriate teaching learning goals
- ▣ *Teaching is a triadic relation and tripolar process involving the source of teaching (human or material), student and a set of activities designed and manipulated primarily to bring changes in the behaviour of the students.*

DEFINITIONS OF TEACHING

- ▣ According to H. C. Morrison, “teaching is an intimate contact between a more mature personality and less mature one which is design to further the education of a situation.”
- ▣ Thomas P green defines, “Teaching is the task of a teacher which is performed for the development of a child.”
- ▣ Amidon and Hunter (1967): “Teaching is an interactive process, primarily involving classroom talk, which takes place between teacher and pupils and occurs during certain definable activities” .

NATURE OF TEACHING

- ▣ Complex social process
- ▣ Both conscious and unconscious
- ▣ Formal as well as informal
- ▣ Relation between three focal points
- ▣ Help in adjustment of the child
- ▣ Skilled occupation
- ▣ Both art and science
- ▣ Teaching is guidance
- ▣ Training of emotions

TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS

- ▣ The acquisition of knowledge, skills and attitudes which enables us to adjust ourselves in an effective manner to the environment may be said to be the aim of teaching-learning.
- ▣ Teaching-learning process is a mean whereby society trains its young ones in a selected environment (the school) as quickly as possible to adjust themselves to the world in which they live.

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS (Contd..)

- ▣ Teaching-learning process implies that all the various elements of the teaching-learning situation have to be brought into an intelligible whole.
- ▣ Teaching learning is influence by the totality of the situation. Teaching learning is fruitful and permanent if the total situation is related to the life situations.

NATURE OF TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

- ▣ Acquisition of knowledge, skills and attitudes
- ▣ means to train adjust themselves to the world in which they live.
- ▣ Teaching-learning has four aspects: teacher, students, learning process and learning situation.
- ▣ a means through which the teacher, learner, the curriculum and other variable are organised in a systematic manner to attain pre-determined goals and objectives.

NATURE OF TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

- ▣ Teaching learning include learners and their individual differences, the methods of teaching, the material to be taught, classroom conditions, teaching devices and aids, questioning and answering, assignments.
- ▣ It also includes thinking, enjoying, creating, practical skills, etc
